## **INTER-BREED**

### **THE AVON FARMERS LTD. PERPETUAL CHALLENGE TROPHY FOR THE BEST PAIR OF HEIFERS (INTER-BREED)**

Each Breed Judge to select one Pair of Heifers to compete for the above Trophy. To be judged by the Breed Judges, awarding up to a maximum of 10 points for each pair. The winners being the pair with the highest aggregate.

### **THE HARRY COCK CHALLENGE TROPHY**

The Harry Cock Perpetual Challenge Trophy, presented by his friends to the Camborne Show Society as a tribute to the memory of Mr. H.S. Cock, Hon. Secretary Cattle Section 1943-49, will be awarded to the Dairy Breed judged to have the best Team Exhibit as set out in the conditions below.

To be judged by the Dairy Breed Judges awarding up to a maximum of 10 points to each breed. The winning team to be the team with the highest aggregate.

#### **CONDITIONS**

1. Each entry to consist of 5 cows and/or heifers drawn from each of the following dairy breeds: Ayrshires, Jerseys, Guernseys & Holsteins.
2. Each cow or heifer in the team must be entered and shown in the respective class for its breed.
3. Each breed may enter only one team.
4. The team will be selected by the Breed Judge on the day of the Show.
5. The winning team will be selected both on the merits of the quality, conformation and condition of each individual cow or heifer in the team as a whole.
6. The Cattle Committee of the Camborne Show Society reserve the right to alter these conditions if circumstances make this necessary.

### **THE MITCHELL & WEBBER PERPETUAL CHALLENGE TROPHY FOR THE SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP**

Each Breed Judge to nominate one entry to be presented for the competition for the Supreme Champion and Reserve Champion; to be judged by the Breed Judges, placing the entries in order of merit and awarding up to a maximum of 10 points for each breed. The Supreme Champion to be the entry with the highest aggregate.

A Tankard by the Camborne Show Society will be awarded to the winner of the Supreme Championship.

### **THE COGEGOES PERPETUAL CHALLENGE CUP**

To be presented to the best animal in the Show of the opposite sex to the Supreme Champion. In the event of no males being selected for the Supreme Championship the appropriate Breed Judges will select the Best Male from their respective breeds to

compete for the Cogegoes Cup, the winner being selected by the Breed Judges under the same conditions as in the Supreme Championship.

**THE PEAT MARWICK McCLINTOCK PERPETUAL TROPHY FOR THE 2<sup>nd</sup> BEST ANIMAL IN THE SHOW (OTHER THAN THE COGEGOES CUP WINNER).**

**THE MIKE HAWKEN PERPETUAL TROPHY, TO BE AWARDED TO THE EXHIBITOR GAINING MOST POINTS IN THE SHOW. (Excluding YFC & Junior Classes)**

### **CATTLE SECTION RULES**

1. No entry will be accepted unless the entry form is properly completed by and signed by the Exhibitor or his Agent and the necessary fees must accompany the entry.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of their entries and should an Exhibitor fail to prove the correctness of any entry when requested to do so, the entry in question may be disqualified and any award made to such an entry cancelled. An Exhibitor who knowingly signs an incorrect entry form may be disqualified from entering future Shows of the Society.
3. An Exhibitor may withdraw a duly accepted entry and substitute another animal in the same class, up to seven days before the Show. Any substitution after this time may incur a full entry fee.
4. Entries received later than 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2011 cannot be guaranteed to appear in the Catalogue. Late entries will be posted in the Secretaries tent.
5. All cattle may compete in as many classes as they are eligible for, on payment of a separate fee for each entry.
6. All Bulls above one year must be secured by a ring in the nose, with a chain or leading staff attached, with two handlers.
7. All entries must be halter led in the ring and double-tied in the lines.
8. 'In Milk' classes will be milked at the respective Breed Judge's discretion.
9. Fodder cannot be supplied by the Society.
10. The Society will arrange milking facilities, but not units.
11. No 'Nomination Entries' will be accepted.
12. **All perpetual trophies won in the forthcoming show are to be returned returned to the Cattle Section Secretary by 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2012**
13. The Cattle Committee reserve the right to reject or cancel any entry or entries if they deem it fit to do so, and the right to cancel or amalgamate any class/es. In the case of cancellation, fees will be refunded.
14. Any person in the judgement of the Cattle Committee, who has broken any of the Society's rules or has been guilty of dishonest or unfair conduct in connection with the Show in question or of any previous show of the Society may be excluded from exhibiting.
15. All animals sent for exhibition may be inspected by the Society's Hon. Veterinary Officer, who is authorized to exclude any animal affected by any

- complaint or disease likely to prove dangerous to other animals, furnishing a certificate thereof to the person in charge of the animal.
16. The Society may require any exhibitor to pay a sum not exceeding £25 as and for liquidated damages if any animal which such an Exhibitor sends for exhibition is, in the opinion of the Society's Hon. Veterinary Officer, affected by any contagious or infectious disease or with any form of complaint or disease likely to prove dangerous to other animals.
  17. All animals must be accredited.
  18. The Judges' decision will be final.
  19. Any cases of dispute will be referred to the Chairman and two other members of the Cattle Committee and their decision shall be final.
  20. Any Exhibitor wishing to enter a protest must do so in writing to the Secretaries of the Cattle Section, accompanied by a deposit of FIVE POUNDS. If on investigation the protest is not sustained the deposit may be forfeit to the funds of the Committee. In the case of any protest whereby any Prize Animal becomes disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize awarded to the disqualified animal then the lowest prize will go to the reserve number. No protests can be registered after the conclusion of the Show.
  21. All persons in charge of exhibits must be in attendance on the animals in their charge throughout the day of the Show and will be subject to the direction of the Society's Officials. They will parade or exhibit the animals in their charge at such times as may be required.
  22. No one will be allowed in the Judging Rings whilst the animals are being judged except Officials of the Society and those in charge of animals being exhibited.
  23. No placards offering animals for sale or any other notice shall be displayed in any part of the Show Yard without the written permission of the Hon. Secretary being obtained.
  24. Stewards, Judges and Exhibitors will be required to follow current Show Guidelines as published by DEFRA.
  25. The Camborne Show Committee will not be liable for loss, damage or injury to any persons or property which may occur on the Show Ground or adjacent grounds used in connection with the Show.
